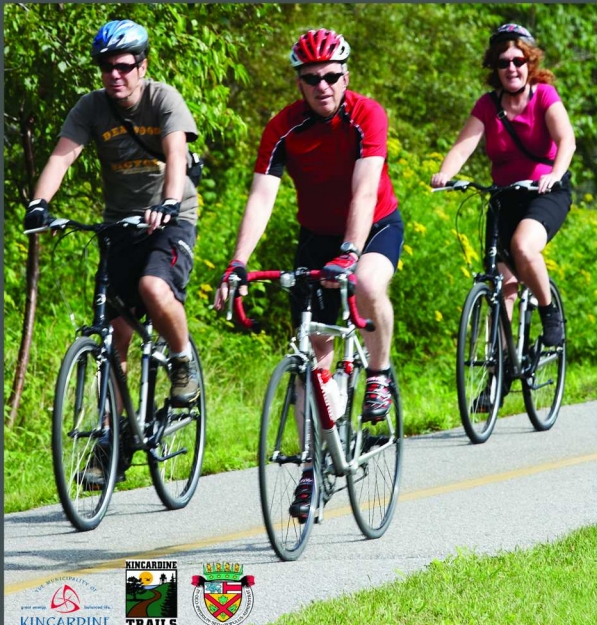


KINCARDINE to INVERHURON PROVINCIAL PARK (KIPP) TRAIL



KIPP TRAIL CONNECTING COMMUNITIES

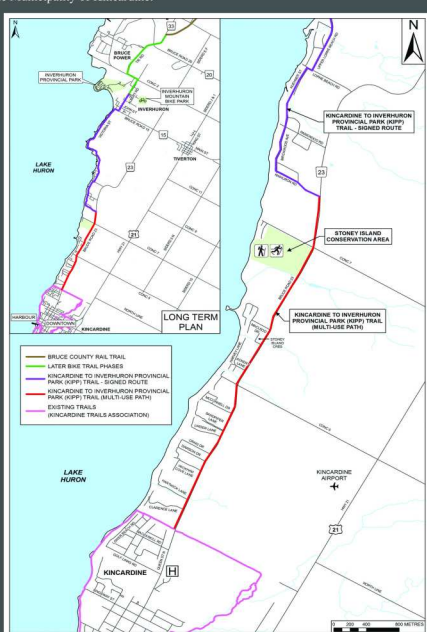
Across Ontario, trail use is recognized as one of the top three recreational pursuits with a participation rate of 20% and an estimated growth rate of 2.3% according to the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport. The Kincardine Trails Association (KTA) has acknowledged this trend and is proactively seeking to expand the passive-use trail system, with the support of the County of Bruce and the Municipality of Kincardine.

The Kincardine Trails Association was formed in 2001 and is a committee of Kincardine Council. The KTA has developed 30km of trails to date thanks in part to the Municipal Public Works staff and our many volunteers. The Kincardine Trails Strategy document defines the trail system into three areas namely;
Phase I - Town of Kincardine
Phase II - Kincardine to Inverhuron Provincial Park
Phase III - Inverhuron Provincial Park to the north municipal boundary (by using part of the 78km Bruce County Rail Trail).

Phase II, aka the 'KIPP Trail' will make use of the west portion of the Bruce Road 23 (B-Line) ditch for the 5km between Huron Ridge and Kin Huron subdivisions. The trail will then avail the lower roads, trails and pedestrian bridges to connect to the South East corner of Inverhuron Provincial Park.

This proposed addition of a 12km trail from Kincardine north to Inverhuron Provincial Park, will address the increased demand for active transportation and recreational opportunities. This initiative is scheduled to occur during 2016 through 2018.

KIPP TRAIL BENEFITS OF PROVIDING SUPPORT

Trail activities have a significant realized benefit relating to health, safety, recreation, economic and environmental impacts. This is accomplished by:



- Encouraging active participation in trail activities leading to enhanced trail user **HEALTH**, wellness and lifestyle.
- Increasing **SAFETY** for cyclists by providing separation between Bruce Road 23 motorized vehicle traffic and cyclists during travel on this route to destinations such as Bruce Power and identified regional cycling tour routes.
- Connecting communities and providing direct links to other **RECREATIONAL** facilities such as Stoney Island Conservation Area, Inverhuron Mountain Bike Park, Inverhuron Provincial Park and the 78km Bruce County Rail Trail
- Enhancing **ECONOMIC** gains resulting from additional recreational cyclists using the inter-linked KTA Trail System that will connect to adjacent communities.
- Providing a positive **ENVIRONMENTAL** impact by reducing air pollution and curbing exhaust emissions due to the increased use of active transportation methods.

The **KIPP Trail** will connect to the 4km Scenic Drive Trail in Inverhuron Provincial Park that travels past a lime kiln located near Gunn Point. Trails users will also be fascinated by the dolostone display that was created from the bodies of ancient sea creatures compressed over millions of years. A great bit of history is that this dolostone was quarried and used to build the Chantry Island (Southampton) and Point Clark lighthouses. The park sand dunes hold evidence of the fact that Inverhuron has had human inhabitants for over 4000 years.

Cyclists should pack their swim suits and enjoy the beautiful sand beach and awe inspiring sunsets while visiting the park.

NOTE: There is **NO** entrance fee for walk-in, bike-in access to Provincial Parks.
